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NEWSLETTER – EARLY YEARS PUPIL PREMIUM

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE MONTH...

Do you know what Early Years Pupil Premium is?

From April 2015, nurseries and other childcare providers have been able to claim extra funding through Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) to support children's development, learning and care.

The EYPP is funding for the nursery, allocated by Havering. Three and four year old children whose parents are in receipt of certain benefits or meet other criteria could be eligible for EYPP funding. This means an extra £302 a year, for each child taking up the full 570 hours, could be assigned to the setting to improve that individual's learning and development.

What this means to Little Learners?

If your child is eligible based on the criteria being met, the nursery could use this money to provide specific care that benefits your child.

This additional money means we are able to buy new resources, improve the setting, go on specific learning trips or provide additional training for practitioners!

Are you eligible?

The setting can receive EYPP if your family receives one of the following:

- Income support
- You receive JSA
- Income related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part vi of the immigration and Asylum act 1999

- Working tax credit run-on, which is paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for working tax credit

or

- Your child is currently being looked after by a local authority
- Your child is adopted
- You have a special guardianship order
- A child arrangement order is in place.

Next Steps

In the following weeks you will receive a letter from the nursery. This will ask for some personal information and if you believe you are eligible, please give your consent for the nursery to apply on your behalf! This will benefit everyone!
