Pre-existing injury form

Over recent weeks you may have noticed you are being asked to fill in a 'pre-existing injury form' if your child arrives at nursery with a bruise or cut as a result of an accident at the weekend or in the evening.

It's very common for children to bump themselves and cause injury! And we want to be confident we know each child's state of wellbeing as they arrive to start their day with us.

Learning from some safeguarding training we had during inset day in January, we're all now on the alert to spot bumps, bruises, scratches or scrapes. Do let us know if your child has had an accident at home, so that we can work together with you to make sure we know how any bumps and bruises that we spot happened.

This raised awareness really helps to provide the best, safest environment for your children.

Holiday forms

We've introduced holiday forms to the nursery!

When you plan a holiday we'd like you to let us know so that we can document the dates your child will be absent (and note where they are going so we can ask them all about it afterwards!)

This helps to plan specific activities, as well as adjusting to a decrease in numbers.

The decrease in numbers often means that staff are more able to take the remaining children on trips or can use the additional time to add extra detail into observations and help track key children's development.
