Topic Program - November 2022

In the month of November, the children at Little Learners Nursery and Preschool will be developing their knowledge and understanding about different topics. Our first topic is Dinosaurs, the children will be learning about different dinosaur species. Another topic will be remembrance Sunday, the children will make different arts and crafts to celebrate Remembrance Day. Our final topic will be St Andrews Day (30/11/22). These topics will be relatable to the seven areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage. The EYFS sets the standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to five years old.

Dinosaurs

The children and practitioners at Little Learners will be doing various activities around dinosaurs.

Incorporating our specific area understanding the world, The children will be learning all different facts about dinosaurs such as where they lived, what they ate and how big/small they were.



Express Arts and design activities that the children will have a chance to participate in, include different messy trays that will incorporate different species of dinosaur's senses and using different materials to create the dinosaur's habitat. Whilst also getting creative making different dinosaur inspired arts and crafts.

Mathematical opportunities will arise through baking dinosaur

dinosaur biscuits. Enhancing the children's development on measuring out the ingredients needed.

Here at little learners we promote and develop activities through each of our children's interests, as we feel this is how the children earn best. So the practitioners will also be enhancing activities following on from the interests the children have shown or what they specify they would like to do.
