Topic Program - February 2023

In the month of February, the children at Little Learners
Nursery and Preschool will be developing their knowledge and understanding about:
Space and Saint Valentine's.

These topics will be relatable to the seven areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage. The EYFS sets the standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to five years old within our setting.

Space

Space is a fascinating subject for all ages! But for children, it is even more mesmerizing. It is so abstract, so strange, and so captivating at the same time which helps children to use their imagination and get creative! The solar system, the moon, planets, rocket ships, astronauts and so much more are all so exciting and will be featuring daily!

The Solar System is made up of the Sun and all the smaller objects that move around it... Apart from the Sun, the largest members of the Solar System are the eight major planets. Nearest the Sun are four small, rocky planets - Mercury, Venus, Earth and Mars... this children will make their own Space planets for display!

The children will be participating in many activities relating to space such as moon sand play, making our own planets, slime play, messy tray activities, science experiments, making rockets and stories about space.



St Valentines

The purpose of Valentine's Day is to celebrate St Valentine- share love, affection, appreciation for those special people around us.

Children of all ages will have the opportunity to participate in art activities by making Valentine's cards and pictures for the people that they love and care about.

Older children in the preschool room with learn about the complex feelings of empathy, compassion and selflessness. Whilst younger children with learn sharing and companionship.

Children will develop mathematics skills by counting out ingredients, measuring liquids, mixing foods together and enjoy baking love heart cookies and sharing them with friends and family.

If the weather is good, we will go to the local shops to see decorations and items that are sold to celebrate Valentine's Day. This topic is closely related to the personal, social and emotional development area of the EYFS as the children learn how to show they love and care about others.




Core books


home: the rocket! How will Dino get them back home?
