Topic program - March 2023- People who help us

During March 2023, the children at Little Learners Nursery and Preschool will be developing their knowledge and understanding about 'People who help us' and Mother's Day. *All topics of learning will be relatable to the seven areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage. The EYFS sets the standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to five years old.*

People who help us

The children will be learning primarily about how the Emergency services, what their roles are, how to contact them and how important they are within our community. Children will understand various roles and how others help us in society. Becca has contacted both the fire brigade and the local police force in an attempt to arrange visits to the nursery - will keep you in the loop if they are available!



We will not just be fixating our attention the emergency services... we will also be recognising what other people in the community can do to help us EG Lolly-pop Assistant, shop operatives, library workers, bus drivers...and especially our teachers and family!

The children will be able to participate in various activities such as role play, going for walks in the local community to find people who help us, create beautiful art work. With children 3 years and older, they will be a little more aware about occupations and may even want to become a helper themselves!

The nursery staff will be teaching some important life skills to the preschool children:

- 1) How to put an adult into the recovery position.
- 2) Putting bandages and slings on themselves and peers- basic first aid... what to do if you cut yourself or burn yourself ECT.
- 3) Encouraging the children to learn their parents names and home address' so they can confidently tell an adult if they are ever lost.
- 4) Stranger danger!
- 5) Road safety
- 6) What number to call if they are ever in danger- 999!

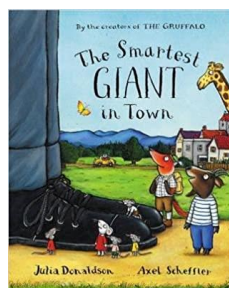
Core books Week 1&2: 'People who help us'
